Thank you for your interest in serving with the JAARS Aviation Department. To help us effectively evaluate your suitability, matched with our needs, please take a few minutes to fill out this questionnaire.

Facts to consider:

1. Volunteer JAARS pilots may **only** be used for Mission at the Airport (MATA) events. Our policy does not allow involvement in flight training or overseas flying

Missions at the Airport (MATA) is to create awareness and interest in the work of JAARS and our support of Bible translation by engaging the public through local community, church sponsored, and school events. Our desire is for people to become engaged by praying, giving, and serving.

2. The MATA flying season typically extends from March to October each year
3. Flying is a bit sporadic, typically 50–75 hours a year, per pilot
4. Staff may be away from home for multiple weeks at a time
5. Pilots are expected to engage in public speaking representing JAARS
6. JAARS pilot mandatory retirement age is reaching your 66th birthday

Requirements to become a volunteer pilot with JAARS:

1. Valid Class II FAA Medical certificate
2. Commercial Pilot License
3. Instrument Rating (airplane only)
4. Tailwheel aircraft endorsement (airplane only)
5. Experience in high performance aircraft (airplane only)
6. Minimum 1000 hours flight time
7. Minimum 50 hours experience within the last six months
8. Pass a one week JAARS Technical Evaluation (estimated cost \$2500)
9. Complete a JAARS Flight Orientation Course (five months, your estimated cost \$5,400, JAARS contribution \$4,400)
10. All course costs do not include housing expense
