The Impact of Bible Translation

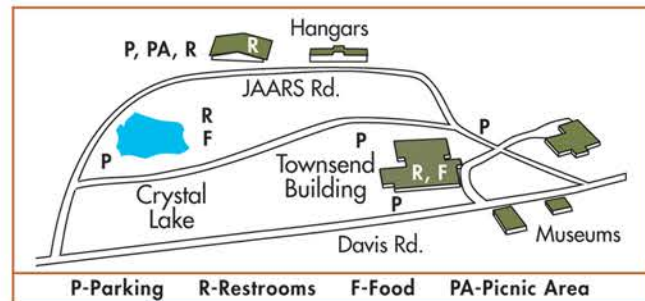
The Sursurunga of Papua New Guinea believe evil spirits will seize the spirit of a child who cries, causing sickness and death. So parents lie to their children to hinder crying: "Tala, we need to go." Little Tala refuses and cries, so his mother says, "There's a truck outside. Do you want to go for a ride?" There's no truck, but he stops crying and goes with his mother.

In May 2011, a group of Sursurunga people were learning how to study their recently translated New Testament. They heard that lying is a sin against God and were convicted to change the way they relate to their children. "The talk about truth really pierced my liver, causing me to feel sorrow and begin new behavior. I am committed to speak the truth to my new grandchild," said one man.

Did You Know?

Although Bible translation is progressing faster than ever before, an overwhelming amount of work has yet to be done. As of October 2017, there are still nearly 600 million people who have little-to-no Scripture in the language they can clearly understand, including about 220 million people who don't have a single word of Scripture in the language that speaks to their hearts.

We need people—like you—going, giving, and praying to provide God's Word to those waiting. We are trusting God to provide workers for over 1,800 open translation-related positions around the world - including many here at JAARS - and to provide the funding needed to complete translation programs in progress and start the remaining languages.
